### This week's learning



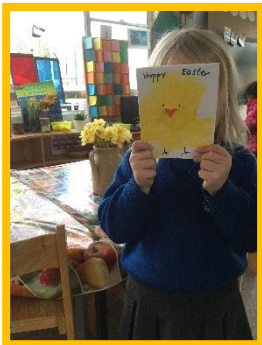
This week we are learning about signs of Spring and Easter celebrations. We dyed eggs, decorated a gigantic egg for a Nursery display and talked about new life.
