We need your help

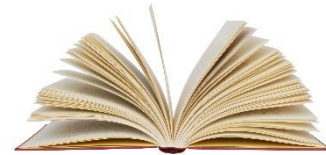


This term We are learning about people who help us. The children would love to see a real doctor, nurse, police officer, road officer, firefighter or builder.
