### Cooking time



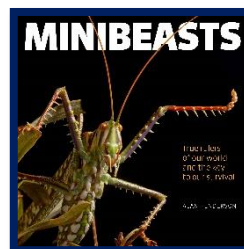
The children enjoyed their cooking lesson on Wednesday. As we were learning about vegetables, we decided to make healthy vegetable chips. The children
