The children were introduced to next term's topic: 'Minibeasts'. They enjoyed reading a story about Superworm. As part of our learning, we went on a worm hunt and made our own wormery.

We explored our outdoor area and looked for minibeasts. We also talked about their characteristics.

The children painted minibeasts, looking at their body shapes trying to spot and copy the differences. We had so much fun looking for worms in

the soil, using tweezers and practising our fine motor skills.
