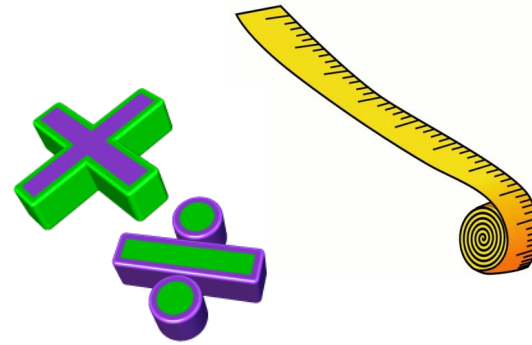

LO: Understand King John's contribution to England.



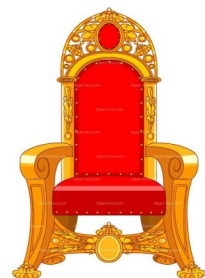

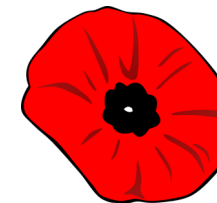
