

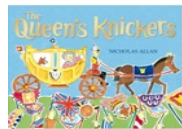

This half term the value we will be learning about is **EQUALITY.**

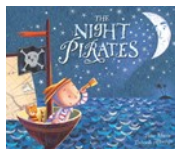

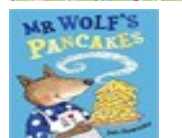

Our key learning in maths will be...

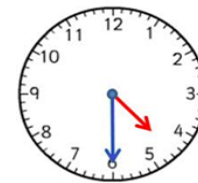
LO: To find halves and quarters.
