This week, the children explored how to compose music on an interactive whiteboard. They had so much fun, exploring various sounds and rhythms. On Friday, the children planted cloves of garlic and onions in Edible Playground. We ensure that we visit the garden every Friday to water and watch the vegetables grow. The children enjoyed dressing up and the role play area. They dressed up as pirates and built the pirate ship in the construction area. To practice our name recognition, we played with magnetic letters and tweezers in the grass tray outside. The children practiced recognizing the initial sounds of their names. Reading the story 'Stickman' the children helped their teachers to create a lovely display and made their stickman.
